### **In the Rhône zone: Jorian Hill**

“Finely honed aromas of tangerine, dried apricot and peach, and orange Creamsicle waft from the wine glass like a mysterious perfume, at once scintillating and inviting. In the mouth, succulent peach and apricot flavors couple with nectarine to coalesce into a sort of creamy peach melba. This is a mouth-filling wine that sports gravity and texture but is smooth as well as complex. Very few viogniers have such incredible flavor staying power, with its fruit and minerality echoing on midpalate all the way through to the extended and lengthy finish. It ends on a high but continually flavored note of acidity. Not many viogniers are this well made, refreshing and food-friendly.”
