“This offers up very complex aromas of sweet candied fruits, dried hay, smoky oak, diesel exhaust, forest floor, raw beef and a really strong black tea top note. Nicely rich and quite bright with succulent acidity lending this a red fruited character. The tannins creep up on the mid-palate and really begin to assert themselves, adding an autumnal character to the forest floor and dried herb notes...The finish is a bit clipped by the tannins, though the brief flash of red fruit is pure and fresh. The wine is aromatically quite decadent, though, which does bode well for the future.”
