### 2007 Jorian Hill Syrah



**“This is a full-bodied Syrah with lots of oak and plenty of alcohol and yet it is not over-the-top in my opinion. It avoids the common Syrah pitfalls of baked fruit character and monolithic flavors, because it expresses fresh, juicy dark berry fruit with mineral notes of ink in its aroma, and suggests fresh herbs, spice, fresh blackberry and black cherry in its flavors. Even more important, the wine has depth in your mouth, and enough acidity to work well on the table. It would most likely benefit from another year or two of age. A big wine, but not a bruiser.”**
